


MEET YOUR NEW DEACON

Deacon Paul has served in a number of ministries including youth ministry, homeless shelters, jails and prisons, hospitals, Kairos, Meals on Wheels, and Second Harvest. He currently serves in ministry to the sick at IU/Methodist Hospital, visiting, counseling, and praying with patients and families and bringing them Eucharist. He and his wife, Sandy, volunteer as CASA's (Court Appointed Special Advocates) for abused or neglected children in Johnson County. Deacon Paul has served various parishes and dioceses in music ministry, as a lector and Eucharistic minister, CRHP teams, Cursillo, marriage and sacramental prep, chaired pastoral councils, served on Catholic school boards, and served on the RCIA Liturgy Committee for the Diocese of Dallas. For the past three years he has served on the RCIA team at St. Mark's as a catechist.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTION

Deacon Paul received a certificate in Spiritual Direction after a two-year course of studies and practicum at Our Lady of Grace Monastery. He serves as one of two discernment companions for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis for those seeking spiritual direction as well as providing spiritual direction himself.
